## Supply List

### Fabric:

Practice fabric (not white)

### Thread:

Contrasting color

### Circle template:

For longarm machine: ¼" acrylic template, approximately half the size of the quilt block.

Example: A 5" circle works well in a 10" block.

For domestic machine: a circular object that can be used to trace a circle in the middle of a block.

Example: A drinking glass works well.

### Other Supplies:

Newsprint

Permanent marker

Chalk wheel filled with white chalk or chalkboard chalk sticks, sharpened

- #6402 - Scissors
- #10738 - Pins

### Optional:

Stencil with 1" lines

Chalk pounce with white chalk

- #11198 - Air-erase marker
- #10698 - Water-soluble marking pen
- #11874 - Iron
- #12136 - Ironing Surface
